Dear Dr Chen,

I am writing to thank you for your help in assisting my husband and I falling pregnant and for the safe delivery of our baby girl.

Previously I had a miscarriage that my doctor believed was due to having a positive result to anti-cardiolipin antibodies. This meant that when I fell pregnant again I would need to inject Clexane daily to prevent miscarrying.

I continued with Dr Chen's treatment for the first four months of my pregnancy. I didn't suffer morning sickness and had a very easy and healthy pregnancy. In December last year we delivered a healthy little girl who has been a very happy and settled baby.
