I was 56 when in 2002 i was diagnosed with primary peritoneal ovarian Cancer. Prior to my diagnosis i was experiencing abdominal pain, My GP sent me to have several tests to find the source. Tests such as colonoscopy, endoscopy and a blood test called CA125, All tests Gave a negative result

Pain started to spread to my lower back and i begun to bloat and have severe pain in my abdominal. I was sent for another CA125 and it returned positive for Cancer and a CT scan showed a tumour. so November in 2002 i underwent a supra colic omentectomy, debulking and removing the peritoneum in the abdomen and pelvis at west mead private hospital.

After my operation i commended 6 cycles of Chemotherapy because my surgeon was only able to remove 90% of the Tumour due to the nature of my cancer. After my Final cycle my Niece informed me that while searching the internet she found a Person who specialises in Chinese Medicine and Acupuncture.
